We plan to work effectively with persons of authority to bring this matter to attention. There are additional noise elements other than the trolley in this residential location that could also be improved. Supporters hope the impact will be assessed and that solutions will be developed to benefit as many people as possible.

Funding for improvements is being requested to be provided by Metropolitan Transit, environment agencies, SanDag, Caltrans, and from other programs that requestors could be eligible for. The area of 1960 homes was identified in 1989 for environment decibel impact and has gotten worse and worse with transportation expansion. Statistics indicate that there can be more crime in areas that are impacted by noise and the quality of life may be reduced considerably.
